

Hearing Test Clinic Client Information

Prior to your appointment:

- Complete the history form and email to the Clinical Neurophysiology Lab technician, Chelsea Crowe (cmcrowe@ucdavis.edu)

Day of your Hearing Test Clinic appointment:

- Park in the Small Animal Parking Lot at UC Davis VMTH
- Note the number of the parking space
- Call the Clinical Neurophysiology Lab at 530-753-7267 to let us know you have arrived, and which parking space we can find you
- Someone will meet you in the parking lot to take your dog to the Lab. Please wear a mask! *Please note: you will **not** be checking in through the regular reception area – the Hearing Test Clinic will check in patients separately.*
- If there are any additional questions about the history, we will contact you by phone to clarify
- After the hearing test, the Neurology/Neurosurgery Service clinician will call you with verbal results and any additional recommendations
- We will return your dog to you in the parking lot, and you can leave!
- We will email you instructions with a summary of the findings & additional recommendations by the end of the day.
- Your veterinarian will receive a copy of the visit record and hearing test results

If additional diagnostic procedures are recommended:

- Because the Hearing Test Clinic is designed to provide rapid assessment of just the hearing status of the patient, a complete neurological exam will not be performed, and the patient cannot be admitted for any additional testing beyond the hearing test. If the clinician recommends additional diagnostics, like a CT scan or MRI, you will need to schedule a regular appointment for more extensive evaluation.
